



Eco-Enrichers

Science – Grade 1-3

Students learn about and observe earthworms.

Materials:

- One earthworm
- Large, damp paper towel
- Magnifying glass
- Spray bottle

Instructions:

1. Create a KWL (What I Know, What I Want to Know, and What I Learned) chart on earthworms.
2. Give each child or group of children an earthworm and a damp paper towel. If needed, keep the worms bodies moist by spraying with a spray bottle filled with water.
3. Allow time for the children to observe the worm. How does it move? What color is it? What does its skin look like? What does the worm do?
4. When finished, complete the KWL chart with the things the children have learned about the earthworms.
